Re. land in possession of
John Lansey

The land in question in possession of John Lansey formerly escheated and sometime in the possession of John Mann--

John Fosieg, 73, declared that John Bayley sold John Warren (35 or 36 yrs. old) but 75 a. of land, and that Warren lived on 150 a. of land wch. was then made escheatable to Lord Balt., which was the land which John Mann sold to John Shatteless and Henry Spink. He heard Augustinian Warren, son of John, often say that the pear tree was the boundary between John Bayley + his father, the tree standing within 40 to 50 yds. of the valley wch. is the boundary. He also heard John Warren say that the Poplar wch. he saw green and is now dead is the bound between John Bayley and John Warren. John Bayley tendered the whole tract of land he the sd. dept. had, wch. was but 150 a.. Further he sd. that Bayley never had any pretensions to the land wch. was Mann's land sold from the sd. John to John Shatteless and Henry Spink.
