Mrs. Mary Pent,,65, deposes that her father John Schertilife + her mother Ann Schertilife + her uncle Henry Spink often said that they sold the tract beginning at the valley where there was a well about 50 or 60 yards from her father's then dwelling house to Edward Cotton. When her parents lived on the land there was a chapel some distance from her father's house -- about 150 yards or thereabouts. Further she said that she heard her parents say that when the land was sold to Cotton there was a reservation made of 10 apple trees between the house then standing and the waterside ~~rock~~. soon after Cotton died , so they lost their priveledge of removing the trees .but by John Warren's entering on the land.
