Inquisition

Concerning land in possession of John Warren formerly belonging to John Shercliff lying in Newtown which was patented to Sherclif on June 5, 1649 for 100 acres m

Beginning bounded on the east by land formerly granted to Richard Hills, and Pisanon Creek: on the south, by the Potomac River on the west, with Broad Creek and on the north by land granted to John Nunne now in possession of John Shercliff.

Shercliff granted this to Edward Cotton on 12, February, 1650

This land is part of a tract of land 450 acres, which cotton gave Warren by will dated 18 April 1653
